Some of Canada's top young scientists, researchers and inventors were on display in Parliament's Centre Block on Wednesday, presenting their science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) projects to Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, Minister of Science and Sport Kirsty Duncan and other federal ministers and officials.

Organized by the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada (NSERC), the second annual Prime Minister's Science Fair welcomed 35 students, ages 10 to 18, from across the country, recognizing them for their work ranging from cancer research to better transport for chicks.
